April 1, 2021

As you've heard previously, the tissue culture lab is separating from Potato Certification Service and will be a stand-alone entity. With this new structure, the money that previously came in through CCPGA and PCS to fund the lab is no longer available.

For this reason, products requested on or after April 1st will have fees associated with them. The chart below lists the various costs. These will be billed separately from PCS fees.

Please note that the only new fee on this schedule is the charge for existing cultivars. This was previously covered by acreage and testing fees but will not be going forward.
