Yellows

AC10376-1W/Y – A high yielding, disease resistant yellow potato, becoming popular with commercial growers in the San Luis Valley.

CO09128-3W/Y - The perfect small potato, high yielding but vey uniform size, this variety produces a lot of B size spuds and thrives in lower fertility conditions.

Rocky Mountain Russet - A high yielding, disease resistant russet variety.

CO10091-1RU - Great Skin Set and very uniform shape this russet is sure to impress.

Masquerade –

A bi-color skin potato with yellow flesh, "the most flavorful potato on the market"

CO05037-2R/Y "Jelly Bean" – Fingerling type with red skin and yellow flesh, easy to grow.

CO05028-4P/PY "Jerry Garcia" - Purple skin with white and purple flesh, this tie dye potato is a fan favorite.

Midnight Moon - Purple skin with yellow flesh, this potato looks great in a medley blend or roasted as a side next to your favorite dish.
